Aims and outcomes

Upon successful completion of this unit, it is expected that students will be able to:

- 3. summarise the strengths and weakness of one major, contemporary non-Christian representation of Christianity;
- 4. explain the role of theology and its intellectual vision in responding to contemporary representations and/or appropriations of Christianity.

Semester 2 starts early with a NEW unit: Intensive – Culture, Beliefs and Theology

This new unit will introduce the content and tasks of Christian theology by engaging a range of representations of Christianity in contemporary intellectual and popular cultures, especially but not exclusively in Australia. These will include objections to Christianity, non-Christian explorations of Christianity, assessments of Christianity by other religions, and secular appropriations of the Christian legacy.

We will explore the work of contemporary authors writing about Christianity, including Richard Dawkins, John Carroll, Karen Armstrong, Alain de Botton, David Tacey, Geoffrey Blainey and Marion Maddox. You will be shown how to identify the theological issues they raise, and so how to contextualise the task and traditions of Christian theology. Overall, this intensive gives you the opportunity to hone approaches for engaging theologically with these thinkers.
